## ORDINANCE No.

Authorize a Site Access Agreement with the Metropolitan Exposition Recreation Commission for the Force Ave Pump Station Remodel Project No. E10611 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has a need to remodel an existing Force Ave. Pump Station located on N. Force Avenue.
- 2. The Force Ave. Pump Station Remodel project requires geotechnical investigations to assess wetwell pumping structure requirements for a site selection alternative analysis. One of the sites under consideration is owned by MERC.
- 3. The Force Ave. Pump Station Remodel project also requires wetland boundary delineation to evaluate permitting requirements that will affect site selection.
- 4. MERC has required indemnification articles in the proposed Site Access Agreement.
- 5. Council authorization is required for the proposed indemnification articles in the Access Agreement.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The BES Director, or his designee is authorized to execute the proposed Access Agreement with MERC for the purposes described in Section 1, provided the Agreement has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
