ORDINANCE No. 188503

Direct the Portland Housing Bureau to adopt median income and maximum monthly rent guidelines (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In order that city-subsidized units affordable to low and moderate income households are utilized by households that are income eligible and that the rents charged to these households are properly regulated, the Portland Housing Bureau has standards for calculating income eligibility and rent.
- 2. To ensure that city-subsidized units are regulated in line with the standards of the Housing Bureau, the compliance measures that maintain the integrity of these programs must be adopted as binding City policy.
- 3. It is appropriate that compliance measures for income eligibility and maximum rent are formalized for consistent use by Housing Bureau staff as well as for transparency and accessibility to entities that receive Housing Bureau subsidies and are required to report on compliance measures.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a) Portland Housing Bureau's maximum monthly rent and median income guideline policies be made consistent with Exhibits A and B.
- b) This ordinance is binding City policy.
