

Project Requirements and Objectives



- On-Call Contracts for Public Sanitary Sewer Extensions
- Maintains sewer service to existing rate payers
- Responsive to situations arising during the City's rapid development climate and old failing private sewers
- Urgent construction required – commonly within 6 months




“Le Happy” – Development Impacts Service

- Small Restaurant sewer crossing developing lot
- Private sewer line in ROW, under water line
- 6 month capping notice



NE 24th Ave - Failed Private Line in ROW



- 4 Residences at risk for back-ups
- Connected laterals live to new lines keep in service

Project Schedule and Budget

- FY 18 - FY 20 - Establish Annual contracts
- Move to Purchasing in July 2017
- 4 contracts targeted for Prime Contractor Development Program from Tier 3 and Tier 4.
- 6 years of experience has proved successful
- BES capital budget allows up to \$3M annually
