Dear Mr. Quinton,

We are closely following the TIF Set-Aside review process in response to an outcry from our members about the lack of affordable housing in Portland. While we recognize that the TIF Set-Aside is a relatively modest amount of funding, it is funding that can be put to immediate use to to begin addressing this crisis. We are encouraged by the Portland Housing Advisory Commission's support of increasing the TIF Set-Aside to 50%, and by the testimony of a respected expert, Leah Greenwood, indicating that it was doable without compromising existing priorities.

We are writing to request a response from the Portland Development Commission on the detailed document presented by Ms. Greenwood at the September 1, 2015 public hearing of the Portland Housing Advisory Commission. "A Roadmap for Getting to a 50% Tax Increment Set Aside for Affordable Housing," provides a detailed pathway to reaching that 50% threshold, largely using existing contingency dollars in each Urban Renewal Area.
