As Mayor and Commissioner of Finance & Administration, I request Council confirmation of the following appointments to the Public Involvement Advisory Council (PIAC).

PIAC, advisory to City Council and City bureaus, works to improve and streamline public involvement policies and practices across the City. PIAC is excited to report that its future work will focus on inclusive and racially equitable community engagement policies, guidance, planning, tools, and best practices. It will also play a greater consultative role to City bureaus. As such, twelve of the recommended appointments are people of color and all recommended appointments have skills, experience, and perspectives that will guide this work. PIAC spent the beginning of this year planning, developing tools, and enhancing the capacity of its existing and incoming membership to serve. This change effort was led by staff Ashley Horne.
