Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of this legislation is to appoint Public Involvement Advisory Council (PIAC) members for staggered 2 and 3 year terms.

PIAC, advisory to City Council and City bureaus, works to improve and streamline public involvement policies and practices across the City. By supporting City staff with policies, guidelines and tools for public involvement, PIAC is helping Portland achieve a more inclusive, representative, equitable, and accountable government. The membership of PIAC includes a balance of diverse community members and City bureau representatives.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Community impacts and community involvement:

Program staff and PIAC members worked extensively to conduct outreach over several months. Clear information about PIAC and the opportunity to serve was made available. Targeted outreach was conducted to a wide range of diverse community organizations and City staff, giving people over a month and a half to respond. Program staff offered to meet one-one one with interested parties and did so upon request. Community member applicants submitted applications and were vetted and rated using established criteria and a facilitated selection process.

The recommended appointments come with the following affiliations: Portland African American Leadership Forum (PAALF) 350 PDX, Urban League, Emerging Leaders Collective for Boys and Girls Club, Lents Strong, East Portland Action Plan (EPAP), A Home for Everyone, Portland Commission on Disabilities (PCOD), Venture Partners, I Have a Dream: Young Leaders Collective, Port of Portland, Meyer Memorial Trust, Portland Public Schools (PPS), Portland State University (PSU), Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (BPS), Office of Management and Finance (OMF), Commissioner Fritz's Office, Portland Housing Bureau (PHB), Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT), Portland Police Bureau (PPB), Bureau of Environmental Services (BES), Bureau of Development Services (BDS), and Portland Parks and Recreation (PPR).

All of the recommended members bring experience, skills, and perspectives that would complement and strengthen the work of PIAC as it continues to strengthen inclusive and racially equitable public involvement policies, guidance, planning, tools, and practices Citywide.
