ORDINANCE No. 188508

*Authorize a contract with Triad Consulting & System Design Group, LLC for Comprehensive Security Assessment and Improvements for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$242,067 (Ordinance; Contract No. 30005911)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Work under this contract includes development of a detailed Security Master Plan for the City. In close coordination with the Bureau of Internal Business Services, City Security Sub-Committee, and the Bureau of Technology Services, the consultant will design a plan to protect visitors, employees, and assets. The consultant will provide: risk assessment & mitigation planning; analysis and recommendation of available technology and system requirements; cost/ benefit analysis of recommendations; an emphasis on open architecture and non-proprietary systems; and an analysis and recommendation of communications upgrades (radio, MRTI, emergency call boxes and telephones), as it affects overall building safety and security.
- 2. The services were advertised under RFP No. 00000486 and eleven responsive responses were received. The selection committee reviewed and scored the proposals in accordance with PCC 5.68 and selected Triad Consulting & System Design Group, LLC.
- 3. The City desires to enter into a PTE contract with Triad Consulting & System Design Group, LLC substantially in accordance with Attachment No. 1, for a not-to-exceed contract amount of \$242,067.
- 4. The M/W/ESB participation in this contract is 100%. Triad Consulting & System Design Group, LLC is a state-certified Minority Business Enterprise (MBE).
- 5. Costs for this contract will be funded by Facilities major maintenance funds for OMF Facilities, and from any bureaus that may wish to add their facilities to the study.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to enter into contract no. 30005911 with Triad Consulting & System Design Group, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$242,067 and in a form substantially in conformance with Attachment No. 1.
- b. The Chief Procurement Officer and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to Triad Consulting & System Design Group, LLC when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists to prevent delays in proceeding with the project. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
