## ORDINANCE No. 188512

Amend contract with TriMet related to development and funding of the Portland Streetcar system and shared regional transit goals (Ordinance; amend Contract No.33000088)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On July 25, 2012, by Ordinance No. 185525, Council authorized a Master Agreement on Streetcar between TriMet and the City.
- 2. The Agreement serves as an overarching agreement covering policy, coordination, and decision-making structure for Streetcar.
- 3. A fundamental guiding policy behind this Agreement was the Region 2040 Growth Concept, which called for housing and employment growth to be focused into more active, mixed use, pedestrian-friendly activity centers that are connected by high-capacity transit corridors. Success of these activity centers requires a multi-modal transportation system that ensures choices and mobility.
- 4. Development of the Portland Streetcar system and Frequent Service Bus network remains essential to supporting healthy neighborhoods, encourage development, and shape Portland within the regional vision.
- 5. As partners, the City of Portland and TriMet, developed the Master Agreement to identify each partner's responsibilities, including cost sharing for Portland Streetcar operations.
- 6. With Amendment No. 1, the partners agree to link the calculation of annual operations funding to Streetcar's cost per revenue vehicle hour.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute Amendment No. 1 with TriMet related to development and funding of the Portland Streetcar system, in a form similar to the contract amendment attached as Exhibit A, as approved by the City Attorney.
