## ORDINANCE No. 188515

Authorize a purchase order with Skeeter Brush Trucks, LLC for the purchase of three wildland brush trucks for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$700,000. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) requires three brush trucks for off-road wildland firefighting. The estimated cost for this purchase is \$700,000.
- 2. The General Obligation Bond passed in 2010 for the replacement of emergency response vehicles provides the entire funding for this purchase.
- 3. City of Portland Code 5.33.170 authorizes the City to participate in Interstate Cooperative Procurements for the acquisition of goods or services when source selection methods have been conducted substantially equivalent to those identified by City Code.
- 4. The Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) has conducted such a solicitation for brush trucks and the resulting contract with Skeeter Brush Trucks, LLC allows such participation by other governmental entities.
- 5. Portland Fire & Rescue seeks Council's authorization to purchase three brush trucks through the HGAC contract for the not-to-exceed amount of \$700,000 by adoption of this ordinance.
- 6. The Bureau's confidence level in the estimated cost is high.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to enter into a purchase order with Skeeter Brush Trucks LLC on behalf of the City for the purposes identified in Section 1.
