

ORDINANCE No. 188523

*Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide for payment for Justice Center Restroom Upgrade and Re-Pipe (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The design for the Justice Center Restroom Upgrade and Re-Pipe project is complete. The construction documents are being prepared to go out to public bid.
2. The cost is estimated to be \$1,686,353. The construction estimate is within the project budget. The project estimate confidence level rating is optimal.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

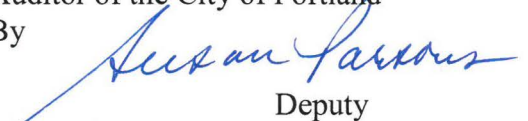
- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process and enter into a contract with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the Justice Center Restroom Upgrade and Re-Pipe project.
- b. The Chief Procurement Officer and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to the 2017-18 Facilities major maintenance fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists to prevent delays in proceeding with the project. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
