

ORDINANCE No. 188525

Authorize a contract with Nelson Nygaard Consulting Associates, Inc. for the development of a Transportation Demand Management Action Plan in the amount of \$157,381 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland's 2035 Comprehensive Plan calls for the development of Transportation Demand Management (TDM) programs as cost-effective ways to increase the number of people walking, bicycling, carpooling and using transit.
2. The City of Portland's Transportation System Plan Update recognizes the role of TDM programs in meeting City-wide transportation and livability goals.
3. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) is proposing to develop a TDM Action Plan to create an implementation process to improve existing programs and create a strategy for aligning with Parking Management Districts.
4. The Northwest District Parking Management Plan and the Central Eastside Parking Management Plan recognize the importance TDM programs play in managing parking in high-demand areas of the city.
5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high, as the contract terms and scope have been negotiated and agreed upon with the firm.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:
