ORDINANCE No. 188529

*Authorize a temporary easement from PS Oregon Inc. for the Tryon Creek Headworks Project E10582 in the amount of \$3,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has a project in the BES Capital Improvement Program to construct a new headworks and perform other improvements at the Tryon Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant.
- The proposed site for the new Tryon Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant facilities is adjacent to 2. the Tryon Creek Wastewater Treatment plant on property owned by PS Oregon Inc.
- BES requires a temporary easement from PS Oregon Inc. to perform site investigations to 3. support project design, permitting, and to determine the extent of future property acquisition from PS Oregon Inc. required for the project.
- 4. The cost of the temporary easement is \$3,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2017-2018 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS element E10582.
- 5. PS Oregon Inc.'s attorneys have required an article of indemnification in the proposed temporary easement.
- 6. Council authorization is required for the proposed indemnification article in the temporary easement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The BES Director, or his designee is authorized to execute the proposed temporary easement a. with PS Oregon Inc. for the purposes described in Section 1, provided the temporary easement has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
- The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the temporary easement from the b. Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
- The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in site investigations will negatively Section 2. impact the cost and schedule of the project and will adversely impact future project property acquisition activities; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
