SUBJECT: Accept the Digital Equity Action Plan Year 1 Progress Report (Report)

We are pleased to submit for your consideration and acceptance the Digital Equity Action Plan Year 1 Progress Report.

In April 2016, the Portland City Council, along with the Multnomah County Board of County Commissioners, and the Multnomah County Library District Board, unanimously adopted the Digital Equity Action Plan (DEAP) (City Resolution No. 37199). The DEAP outlines a series of operational and policy proposals to address digital access and adoption gaps for excluded and disadvantaged communities, specifically people with low incomes, older adults, communities of color, people with disabilities and those with limited English proficiency.

Under the Resolution, the City authorized and directed the Office for Community Technology to engage with other City of Portland bureaus and offices, as well as with County offices, schools, the business community, internet service providers and community organizations in developing a work plan to implement DEAP and to make annual reports to the City Council on progress achieved and barriers encountered regarding closing the digital divide and accomplishments toward digital equity.
