Extend term of contract with Squire Patton Boggs (US) LLP, for federal lobbying. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30004029)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland requires the services of a contractor working in Washington, DC to advise the City and perform other services for the City with respect to interactions with the federal government.
- 2. The City's current contract with Squire Patton Boggs (US), LLP expires on August 31, 2017.
- 3. In April 2017, the Office of Government Relations issued a request for proposals seeking responses from individuals or firms with demonstrated experience in federal government representation to cities, similar in size and issues to the City of Portland. The request for proposal process yielded insufficient number of proposers to be deemed adequate for competitive purposes, correspondingly the request for proposal (RFP) has been cancelled.
- 4. The current contract should be extended until October 31, 2017, to allow for the completion of a new process to solicit a more robust competitive RFP.
- 5. The extension of the current contract will allow for continuing representation for the City of Portland in Washington, DC to the Oregon Congressional delegation, other key members of congress and committees, the Executive Branch, and our partners at national organizations during this RFP process.
- The City budget for FY 2017-18 identifies sufficient funds for an extension of the 6. contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

The Mayor and the Director of the Office of Government Relations are authorized a. to execute an amendment to Contract No. 30004029 with Squire Patton Boggs (US), LLP in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
