Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The *Portland Recycles! Progress Report and Action Plan* provides Council with an update on progress made toward the goals set in the *Portland Recycles! Plan*, unanimously adopted in 2008. The document explains how the adopted *Climate Action Plan* and *Sustainable City Government Principles* together establish new goals and objectives for sustainable materials management moving forward. Finally, the document provides next steps on priority projects for increased food scrap collection at food-generating businesses and improved recycling and equitable service provision at multifamily properties.
