ORDINANCE No. 188539

*Authorize charitable organizations eligible to participate in the City's 2018 Charitable Campaign; and authorize exemptions from umbrella requirement for Portland Parks Foundation and for Portland Fire Bureau Toy & Joy Makers (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. City Council established standards and guidelines for conducting the Charitable Campaign and authorized the use of the payroll deduction system for making donations to charities. The guidelines are reflected in City Code Chapter 5.10.
- 2. The 15 agencies and foundations listed below are being recommended to participate in the 2018 Charitable Campaign.
- 3. Portland Fire Bureau Toy & Joy Makers and Portland Parks Foundation have participated in past City Charitable Campaigns but do not disburse funds to nine member Charitable Organizations; therefore, do not conform with the umbrella requirement in City Code Section 5.10.010B.
- 4. Both Portland Toy & Joy Makers and Portland Parks Foundation have a long and commendable history of providing charitable works for City of Portland community members and have participated in the City Charitable Campaign for a number of years.
- 5. The City's Charitable Campaign Advisory Committee recommends that Portland Toy & Joy Makers and Portland Parks Foundation be allowed to continue to participate in the City's annual Charitable Campaign, notwithstanding the requirements of City Code Section 5.10.010B.
- 6. All other participating agencies have met the Code requirements outlined in Section 5.10. The City's Charitable Campaign Advisory Committee recommends that Council approve the participation of these organizations in the 2018 Campaign.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. An exemption from the umbrella organization requirement for Portland Toy & Joy Makers and Portland Parks Foundation is approved.
- b. The following organizations and their member organizations are eligible to participate in the City's 2018 Charitable Campaign.

 - America's Best Local Charities (formerly Local Independent Charities)
 - America's Charities

- Children's Trust Fund of Oregon
- Community Health Charities of Oregon

- Neighbor to Nation
- Portland Fire Bureau Toy & Joy Makers
- Portland Parks Foundation
- Sunshine Division of the Portland Police Bureau
- Work for Art (Regional Arts & Culture Council)
- United Way of the Columbia-Willamette

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that there be no delay in implementing the City's 2018 Charitable Campaign; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


