

ORDINANCE No. 188543

* Authorize the Police Bureau to donate eight horses and equipment from the Mounted Patrol Unit (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In October 2016, the Mayor and Council gave the Portland Police Bureau guidance for the development of the Fiscal Year 2017-18 budget to provide options to reduce two percent of the budget;
2. The Mounted Patrol Unit (MPU) had a total proposed Fiscal Year 2017-18 budget of \$1,039,469;
3. The MPU was identified as a cut package in the Fiscal Year 2017-18 budget to contribute to the total two percent requested reduction;
4. On May 17, 2017, the Council approved the Annual Budget without funding the Bureau's MPU;
5. The Bureau now has eight horses and MPU-related equipment that are usable surplus property;
6. The horses were either purchased or donated. The average purchase price was \$3,000;
7. Portland City Code 5.36.010(D)(5)(b) requires that Council must approve donations of usable surplus property;
8. The Bureau will strive to find the best possible new homes for each of the horses; and
9. It is beneficial to the City and community that donation of these horses and equipment may be authorized as quickly as possible because the employee positions that care for the horses are not funded in the Fiscal Year 2017-18 budget.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. That the Police Bureau is authorized to donate the MPU eight horses and all related equipment in compliance with Portland City Code 5.36.010(D)(5).

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the employee positions that care for the horses are not funded in the Fiscal Year 2017-18 budget. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
