- Proposals deemed to have met minimum threshold: PCRI/GED and HF/Project^
- RFQ minimum thresholds:
 - Mixed use projects on time and on budget
 - Experience developing 0-60% MFI housing
 - Cost effective building design
 - Sufficient development capacity in-house or through partnerships
 - Ability to assemble financing
 - o Ability to meet funding requirements and conditions
- Basic project/program outline:
 - 45-70 family sized rental units, i.e. 2-3 bedrooms
 - Rental units affordable at 60% MFI and below
 - Apply Preference Policy
 - Active ground floor commercial uses
 - Resources: \$4.5M in Interstate Corridor TIF, plus the site at no cost
 - Other resources: pre-dev loan of up to \$25K, plus technical assistance fund up to \$10K for contracting and workforce development
- Selection Criteria based on "Development Benefits Plan:"
 - Alignment with Community Forums and the North/Northeast Neighborhood Housing Strategy
 - Roles and responsibilities of the development team members
 - Supporting economic opportunity
- Evaluation Committee met on August 10:
 - Unanimously recommended PCRI/Gerding Edlen.
 - o Team also includes Colas Construction and Carleton Hart Architecture
 - Commissioner Saltzman and Mayor held press conference to announce decision at the site August 17.
- Have held kick-off with team meeting to discuss:

 - o Schedule
 - General funding structure
 - o General program
- Next steps:
 - Refine all of the above
 - Recruit for/enlist a project advisory committee
- PAC will:
 - Be made up of people from the community
