- Use the “dissimilarity index”
- Map populations by race, ethnicity, language in relationship to assets and deficiencies
- Public housing patterns

C. Disproportionate Housing Needs

- Which demographic groups experience the most housing/transport burdens
- Where are the housing needs

D. Disparities in Access to Community Assets and Exposure to Adverse Community Factors

- Access to schools
- School stability
- Jobs, job market proximity
- Access to transport
- Exposure to poverty
- Environmental hazards

E. Disability and Access

- Number or accessible units
- Access- i.e. waitlist policies etc...
- Amount of segregation

F. Fair Housing Compliance and Infrastructure

- Unresolved violations of fair housing or civil rights laws
- Patterns of community opposition
- Support or opposition from public officials
- Discrimination in the housing market
- Lack of fair housing education
- Lack of resources for fair housing agencies and organizations
