

**ORDINANCE No.**      188548

\*Authorize an agreement with the Union Pacific Railroad Company to provide design engineering services in the amount of \$25,000 for the NW Naito Parkway Pedestrian Crossing Improvement Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation received a \$389,000 grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation in 2008 for the design and construction of the NW Naito Pedestrian Crossing Improvement Project.
2. During the design engineering phase of the project it was discovered that additional changes to the Steel Bridge railroad crossing of NW Naito Parkway were required to complete the project. These changes include relocation of the crossing gates, the installation of additional track panels and sidewalk improvements.
3. All work associated with the changes to railroad crossing, both design engineering and construction, are required to be performed by the Union Pacific Railroad. In order to have the railroad perform the necessary design engineering work, the Bureau of Transportation must enter into an agreement with the Union Pacific Railroad ("Agreement"), which is attached as Exhibit A.
4. The cost of the services is estimated to be \$25,000, which will be funded by the NW Flanders Bikeway Project, which is funded by Transportation System Development Charges approved by Council in 2016 (Ordinance 187721).
5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is low, because the necessary design engineering has yet to be completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute (1) the Agreement attached as Exhibit A and (2) subsequent amendments to the Agreement provided the amendments do not increase the City's financial risk.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to ensure no delay in moving forward with the agreement; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


