Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

Adopt permanent pedestrian plaza definition and rules of conduct associated with pedestrian plazas. City Council adopted interim rules in July 2016. Based on collaboration with property owners along the demonstration project Ankeny Alley, Portland Police Bureau (especially the Entertainment District detail), the City Attorney’s Office and the Multnomah County District Attorney’s office, modifications to the interim rules were made and are proposed for permanent adoption as City Code.

The legislation establishes code of conduct associated with defined pedestrian plazas and manages expectations between adjacent property and business owners, citizens, and police. Ongoing operational meetings of the Ankeny Alley demonstration project stakeholders have continued since the project was established.
