(4) This permit is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Council and no expenditure of money or lapse of time, or other act or thing, shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland, or be held to give the grantee any vested or other right.
(5) The grantee shall hold the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees free and hamless from any claims for damages to persons or property, including legal fees and costs of defending any actions or suits, including legal fees and costs of defending any arcs or suits, including legal fees and employees as follows:
Bodily injury S100,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, said insurance to be kept in full force and effect at all times. This permit is automatically revoked without further action by the Council if this insurance is permitted to lapse, is cancelled or, for any other reason, becomes inoperative.
(6) The grantee shall pay the permit fee of \$10.00 required by Section 17.24.020 of the City Lodd.
(7) This permit is personal to the grantee and shall not run with the land, nor may the same be transferred, assigned or otherwise disposed of by the grantee.
(8) The grantee shall remburse the City for the cost of filling by the City Auditor of a certified copy of this Drdinance will not become effective until the grantee has filled with the City Auditor bot a document accepting the terms and conditions hereof, and the evidence of insurance, each of which has been approved by the City Autorney.
