(4) This permit is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Council and no expenditure of money or lapse of time, or other act or thing, shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland, or be held to glve the grantee any vested or other right.
(5) The grantee shall hold the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees free and hamless from any clatms for damages to persons or property, fncluding legal fees and costs of defending any actions or suits, including any appeals which may result from the use of the street area under this perinit by providing evidence of insurance protecting the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and enployees as follows:
Bodily injury $\$ 100,000$ for one claimant and $\$ 300,000$ for one occurrence, property damage $\$ 50,000$ for one claimant and $\$ 300,000$ for one occurrence, said insurance to be kept in full force and effect at all times. This permit is automatically revoked without further action by the Council if this insurance is permitted to lapse, is cancelled or, for any other reason, becomes inoperative.
(6) The grantee shall pay the permit fee of $\$ 10.00$ required by Section 17.24.020 of the City Code.
(7) This permit is personal to the grantee and shall not run with the land, nor may the same be transferred, asstenned or otherwise disposed of by the grantee.
(8) The grantee shall reimburse the City for the cost of filing by the City Auditor of a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Records Division of Multnomah County.

Section 2. This Ordinance will not becone effective until the grantee
has filed with the City Auditor both a document accepting the terms and conditions hereof, and the evidence of insurance, each of which has been approved by the City Attorney.

An Ordinance grantidn a revocable perwit to Meier a Frank Co.. Inc, to continue their on-street loading, unloading operations in a portion of SH Alder Street between 5W 5th Avenue and 5K 6 th Avenuc adjacent to their property, and declaring an emergenty.
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Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Meler \& Frank Co., Inc., 621 5W 5th Rvenue, Portland, Oregon 97204 , has requested penmission to continue their onstree: loading, unldading operations for the purposes of transporting goods, raterials, and equipment to and from the store, and for zemporary storage of these goods while in transit in the sidewalk area of 5 Alder Street adjacent to Block 173. Portland, as long as the store remains in operation under the present owners and occupants.
2. That the grantirg of this continuing use of the strect area, under certain conditions, will not be detrimental to the public interest.

NDN, THEREFORE, the COuncil directs:
3. Penmission hersby is granted or, a revocable basis to Hefer: Erank Co., Inc. . grantee, to continue using a portion of $\$ \mathbf{W}$ Alder Street adjacent to their property for their on-street loading, unloading operations of goods, materials and equip= ment over and across the sidewalk area and for temporary storage of these said goods in the sldewalk while in transit. subject to the following whillions:
(1) Yehicles being foaded or unloaded shall be aarked in a manner that will not block nomal passage of other wehicle traffic on SM Alder Street.
[2] That the grantee shall, at all times, provide for the passage of pedestrians in the sidewalk orea adjocent :o their property.
(3) This penmic shall not exempt the grantee from obtaining any license or permit reaulred by the City Code or Ordinatres for any act to be perfomed under this pertit, nor shall this permit wiefve the provisions of any city code, Orulinance, or the City Charter, except as herein stated.

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
