

**ORDINANCE No. 188579**

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of the Concordia Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10677 for \$4,824,200 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to rehabilitate approximately 12,900 feet of sewer main line in the northeast neighborhoods of Concordia, Woodlawn, and Beaumont-Wilshire.
2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating or replacing the deteriorated sewer pipe, including sewer manholes and service laterals
3. The estimated cost is \$4,824,200. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2017-2018 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10677.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.


