Purpose of proposed legislation and background information: This legislation authorizes the Mayor to make application to U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) for the 2017 JAG grant funding opportunity.

The City wishes to apply for grant funding as the fiscal agent on behalf of the jurisdictions certified as disparate - the City of Portland and the City of Gresham. Multnomah County has declined to apply. Gresham will receive \$88,792 and the City of Portland will receive \$296,723.
