

**ORDINANCE No. 188599**

Authorize a competitive solicitation and price agreements for construction management, inspection and project support personnel for an amount not to exceed \$25,000,000 over five years. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has a need for temporary, supplemental personnel for construction management, inspection, and project support on an as-needed basis for peak workload periods for the bureau's Capital Improvement Program (CIP), for projects including storm and sanitary sewers, wastewater pump stations, wastewater treatment facilities, stormwater treatment facilities and drainageway improvements.
2. The estimated cost per year is \$5,000,000, for a total not to exceed \$25,000,000 over five years. The confidence level in this cost is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2017-18 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Capital Improvement Program (within the budget of multiple existing CIP projects).
3. The Bureau seeks City Council's authorization for Procurement Services to issue a competitive solicitation and issue up to two price agreements for the supplemental staffing services above.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process in accordance with code to obtain the most responsible and responsive offers for up to two price agreements for the services described in Section 1, for a maximum not to exceed amount of \$25,000,000 over five years.
- b. Upon Council acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's Report, Procurement Services is authorized to negotiate and execute contracts, provided the contracts have been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- c. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
