## **ORDINANCE No.** 188605

\*Authorize a 10-year lease with Multnomah County School District N. 1J for the Bureau of Technology Services to lease space at NW Skyline Elementary School, 11536 NW Skyline Blvd, through April 15, 2027 in the amount of \$103,175 for antennas for public safety radio coverage (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Technology Services ("BTS")'s Public Safety Technology Division requires space for antennas on the tower structure and within the Skyline Elementary School ("Site") for the transmission and reception of radio communications signals.
- 2. BTS has operated under a Telecommunications Site Lease at this Site since 1997 and wishes to continue operations due to the critical and specific radio coverage provided by the site. The site provides coverage for first responders in crash prone Cornelius Pass Road area.
- 3. Pursuant to Resolution #37017 "Reaffirming the City's Interest to Maximize Investment in City-Owned Facilities and Directing the Office of Management and Finance to Fully Implement ADM" 13.01, the Bureau of Internal Business Services ("BIBS") is working with bureaus to fully implement ADM 13.01 and ART 3.01 by bringing City operations back into City-owned facilities when possible.
- 4. Due to the nature of the BTS' use being specific to Cornelius Pass Road in this rural northwest area, there is no existing City-owned facility or property that could provide a viable option to accommodate the needs of BTS.
- 5. On-going funding for this lease will be provided by the Bureau of Technology Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Director of the Bureau of Internal Business Services or his designee is authorized to execute documents as necessary, once approved as to form by the City Attorney, for the lease at 11536 NW Skyline Boulevard, Portland, Oregon through April 15, 2027.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that this lease agreement may occur without delay; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
