ORDINANCE No. 188611

* Authorize a Request for Proposal to obtain the most responsible and responsive proposer for a new budgeting software system. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City Budget Office (CBO) is responsible for the operation of the citywide budget software system.
- 2. The CBO has determined that the current budgeting software is insufficient in capability and needs to be replaced.
- 3. The CBO requires software with enhanced functionality in order to better meet the needs of bureau finance staff and increase the overall efficiency of the budget process.
- 4. Council previously recognized the need to replace the budget software system and set aside \$1.0 million as a placeholder for CBO to begin the budget software system replacement project and perform due diligence.
- 5. CBO has convened users of the current system to discuss system requirements and potential enhancements. Through this process, and after examining a number of different products, CBO estimates that the total cost of the project could range anywhere from \$1 million to \$3 million. This is a low confidence cost estimate that will not be finalized until the CBO has completed a competitive solicitation process. CBO will develop a funding request and potential options for consideration during the Fall budget monitoring process.
- 6. Procurement of the new system through a competitive solicitation process will ensure the best value for CBO and other City stakeholders.
- 7. CBO seeks Council's authorization for Procurement Services to conduct a competitive solicitation process through the issuance of a Request for Proposal(s).

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to facilitate the competitive solicitation (RFP) process in accordance with City Code 5.33 to obtain the most responsible and responsive proposer, and negotiate a contract to replace the current budgeting software system.
- b. Upon Council acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's Report, Procurement Services is authorized to execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the RFP and forthcoming purchase will result in continued risk of using the current unsupported budgeting software system; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
