ORDINANCE No. 188613

Authorize a contract with Squire Patton Boggs (US) LLP, for federal lobbying not to exceed \$198,000 a year (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland requires the services of a contractor working in Washington, DC to advise the City and perform other services for the City with respect to interactions with the federal government.
- 2. In May 2017, the Office of Government Relations issued a request for proposals seeking responses from individuals or firms with demonstrated experience in federal government representation to cities similar in size and issues to the City of Portland.
- In July 2017, an evaluation committee selected the firm of Squire Patton Boggs (US), LLP. A Notice of Intent to Award was issued, and no protests were submitted.
- 4. The contract would begin on November 1, 2017 and will run through August 31, 2020, with an option to extend for three years.
- 5. The annual contract amount is \$198,000.
- 6. The City budget for FY 2017-18 identifies sufficient funds for this contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and the Director of the Office of Government Relations are authorized to enter into contract with Squire Patton Boggs (US), LLP in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
