

ORDINANCE No. 188613

Authorize a contract with Squire Patton Boggs (US) LLP, for federal lobbying not to exceed \$198,000 a year (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland requires the services of a contractor working in Washington, DC to advise the City and perform other services for the City with respect to interactions with the federal government.
2. In May 2017, the Office of Government Relations issued a request for proposals seeking responses from individuals or firms with demonstrated experience in federal government representation to cities similar in size and issues to the City of Portland.
3. In July 2017, an evaluation committee selected the firm of Squire Patton Boggs (US), LLP. A Notice of Intent to Award was issued, and no protests were submitted.
4. The contract would begin on November 1, 2017 and will run through August 31, 2020, with an option to extend for three years.
5. The annual contract amount is \$198,000.
6. The City budget for FY 2017-18 identifies sufficient funds for this contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Director of the Office of Government Relations are authorized to enter into contract with Squire Patton Boggs (US), LLP in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
