Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

To provide funds to All Hands Raised in FY17-18 to manage the Cradle to Career (C2C) partnership. In FY 16-17 among their six partner districts, examples of the progress being made include: 39% increase in on-time high school graduation rates for students of color over the last five years; 48% fewer suspension and expulsion rates for students of color in 2015/16 over 2011/12; and a 14.8 percentage point increase in FAFSA completion rates in 2016/17 over 2015/16.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Funding for this grant is available in the FY2017-18 budget in the General Fund Special Appropriations.

Community impacts and community involvement:

Since 2012 All hands Raised has partnered with the Coalition of Communities of Color to build more equitable policies and practices. All Hands Raised delivers over \$1.5 million of in-kind support to their six school districts and community partners to help teams identify tangible practices that create measurable improvements. The alignment they build daily is making a positive impact on children, youth and young adults.
