ORDINANCE NO. 188634

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Gresham for \$749,573 for the HOME Investment Partnership Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. In accordance with the HOME Consortium Agreement 30006043, a portion of the U.S. Housing and Urban Development HOME grant is attributable to Gresham's participation in the Consortium, and Gresham is entitled to plan for the expenditure of such funds.
- 2. There is a total of \$749,573 in HOME funds available to Gresham in the Portland Housing Bureau budget, comprised of \$520,988 in FY 2017-18 Gresham HOME funds, \$184,751 in FY 2016-17 carryover funds, and \$43,834 in Program Income.
- 3. The City of Gresham will implement a portion of the HOME Program in the amount of \$700,079. The balance of Gresham's HOME Program funding, \$49,494, will be administered by the City of Portland.
- 4. Funds for this agreement are available in the approved FY 2017-18 Budget for HOME funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Portland Housing Bureau Director and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with City of Gresham for the City of Gresham's HOME Investment Partnership Program in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the program funds must be obligated within required timeframes; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
