Remove gender-specific language in Titles 11 Trees, 24 Building Regulations, 25 Plumbing Regulations, 26 Electrical Regulations, 27 Heating and Ventilating Regulations, and 32 Signs and Related Regulations (Ordinance; amend Code Titles 11, 24, 25, 26, 27 and 32)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1: The Council finds:

- 1. In December 2015, City Council passed Resolution No. 37175 that directed in part, "...the Office of the City Attorney and BHR shall work with all City bureaus to examine their policies and procedures, including but not limited to policy documents, rules and regulations, applications, permits, and contracts, to assess whether gender-specific language in the documents should be eliminated and replaced with gender-neutral language..."
- 2. Per Portland City Title 3, BDS administers and enforces Portland City Titles 24 (Building Regulations), 25 (Plumbing Regulations), 26 (Electrical Regulations), 27 (Heating and Ventilating Regulations) and 32 (Signs and Related Regulations).
- 3. Per Portland City Code Title 3, BDS administers and enforces provisions of Title 11, Trees, as specified in that Title. The Bureau of Parks and Recreation-Urban Forestry also administers and enforces provisions of Title 11 and has agreed to the Title 11 amendments in this ordinance. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability has also agreed to the Title 11 amendments in this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a) Portland City Titles 11, 24, 25, 26, 27 and 32 are amended as follows in Exhibit A.
