TO THE COUNCIL:

On July 20, 2017, Council approved Ordinance Number 188523 for Procurement Services to competitively solicit the Justice Center Restroom Upgrade and Re-Pipe project in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00000683 on behalf of the Office of Management and Finance, Bureau of Internal Business Services(OMF-BIBS), with a project construction estimate of \$1,686,353. OMF-BIBS rated the project estimate confidence level as optimal.

Bids were opened on September 12, 2017, and one (1) bid was received. The low bid from Hydro-Temp Mechanical, Inc., was responsive to the solicitation requirements, thus it is recommended that Hydro-Temp Mechanical, Inc. bid be accepted at the estimated unit prices quoted for a total bid amount of \$1,796,289.

The City, identified an aspirational goal for D/M/W/ESB subcontractor and supplier utilization at 20% of the hard construction costs for the project.

Hydro-Temp Mechanical, Inc. acting as the prime contractor identified the following areas as opportunities for subcontracting: insulation services and plumbing material. There is \$360,165 (20.39%) D/M/W/ESB utilization identified towards the goal. subcontractor/supplier participation represents 0% of the total bid amount and M/W/ESB subcontractor/supplier participation represents 20.39% apportioned as follows:

- ESB \$41,715 performing insulation services
- WBE \$318,450 providing plumbing material.

Hydro-Temp Mechanical, Inc. is located in Wilsonville, Oregon, and is not a State Certified D/M/W/ESB Contractor. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and EEO Certification, and are in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available for this project under Owner Cost Center 9MFFA0000937.

It is recommended that a Performance Bond and Payment Bond each at 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor. Further, it is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
