Authorize a contract with lowest responsible bidder for the SE 50th Ave from SE Division St to SE Hawthorne Blvd street improvement project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On May 17th, 2016, Portland voters passed Measure 26-173, Portland's first local funding source dedicated to fixing our streets. Measure 26-173 will raise an estimated \$64 million over four years. This is the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) Fix Our Street Program.
- 2. As part of Fix Our Streets program, PBOT will be constructing pavement maintenance work on SE 50th Avenue from SE Division St. to SE Hawthorne Boulevard. Work will include updating and/or installing ADA ramps to meet current ADA guidelines and new marked pedestrian crossing.
- 3. The pavement condition on SE 50th Avenue has deteriorated to a point at which a 3 inch grind and overlay is now required.
- 4. Grinding and paving 3 inches at this time meets PBOT's Pavement Management strategy of performing pavement maintenance early in the lifecycle to prevent much higher rehabilitation costs in the future.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate, as the project scope is clearly understood and well defined.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to PBOT T00590 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
