

ORDINANCE No. 188667

* Authorize a purchase order with Pierce Manufacturing, Inc. for four fire apparatus for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$2,800,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) requires four new engines to replace existing aging apparatus. The estimated total cost for this purchase is \$2,800,000.
2. The General Obligation Bond passed in 2010 for the replacement of emergency response vehicles, along with PF&R's 2017-2018 capital fund for apparatus replacement, provides the entire funding for this purchase.
3. City of Portland Code 5.33.170 authorizes the City to participate in Interstate Cooperative Procurements for the acquisition of goods or services when source selection methods have been conducted substantially equivalent to those identified by City Code.
4. The Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) conducted such a solicitation for emergency response apparatus and the resulting contract with Pierce Manufacturing, Inc. allows such participation by other governmental entities.
5. Portland Fire & Rescue seeks Council's authorization to purchase four fire apparatus through the HGAC contract for the not-to-exceed amount of \$2,800,000 by adoption of this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to enter into a purchase order with Pierce Manufacturing, Inc. on behalf of the City for the purposes identified in Section 1.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because of a unit price increase effective December 1, 2017. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
