






Location | Context Photo of Current Crossing



Area of Impact | Site Plan






SMART DESIGN

The Footbridge mimics the shape of sword ferns that line the entire length of the Wildwood Trail. Its delicate structure fits seamlessly into the forest, creating a fluid experience for walkers and runners. Best of all, it's installed quickly at a reasonable cost, and can be maintained easily over the years.
