





### Location | Site Plan




# Location Photo West bound

#### Area of Impact | Site Plan





The Footbridge mimics the shape of sword ferns that line the artire length of the Wildwood Trail. Its delicate structure fits seamlessly into the forest, creating a fluid experience for walkers and runners. Best of all, it's installed quickly at a reasonable cost, and can be maintained easily over the years.



Authorize a Grant Agreement between Portland Parks & Recreation and Portland Parks Foundation for \$500,000 for the Portland Parks Foundation to fund, project manage, design, permit, and construct the Wildwood Trail Pedestrian Bridge.
