ORDINANCE No. 188669

*Authorize a grant agreement with a maximum possible total of \$75,000 to Portland Parks Foundation for operational costs associated with fundraising and development services for the Portland Parks & Recreation programs and projects for FY 2017-18 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. PPF was formed through the PP&R Vision 2020 process to bring new resources, constituencies and expertise to long-term stewardship of parks and recreation.
- 2. Fundraising from private individuals, corporations and foundations is a critical component to the long-term stewardship of Portland's park system and PPF is well positioned to do this development work in the community.
- 3. There is a need for operational funding from the City to support PPF's vital services.
- 4. PPF has shown success in fulfilling its goals and PP&R's goals from a previous grant of \$50,000 during FY2016-17, which supported its efforts so that it was able to raise nearly two million dollars in support of PP&R projects and programs.
- 5. The purpose of this grant is to support fundraising and development services for jointly agreed to priority projects and programs, including, but not limited to, the Footbridge Over Burnside and Summer Free for All.
- 6. PPF will provide annual written reports to PP&R and those reports shall provide specific and detailed information concerning the projects and purposes to which the grant funds are applied.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

- a. The Director of the PP&R is authorized to enter a grant agreement with Portland Parks Foundation for a maximum total of \$75,000 for operational services for FY 2017-2018, subject to available funding. The agreement will be substantially similar to the agreement attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A and will be approved as to form by the City Attorney, prior to execution by the Director.
- b. The Bureau of Portland Parks & Recreation is authorized to make grant payments to PPF in accordance with the terms and conditions stated in the grant agreement.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid further delay in the provision of funding for the ongoing operations of PPF; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
