*Pay claim of Marcia Gesner in the sum of \$30,000 involving Portland Fire and Rescue (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Marcia Gesner, through GLP Attorneys, PLLC, has filed a bodily injury claim against the City for injuries sustained in an auto incident involving Portland Fire and Rescue on February 3, 2015.
- The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The
 investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore,
 in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to
 compromise the claim at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$30,000 (\$5,000 of which has been previously paid) subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$25,000 made payable to GLP Attorneys, PLLC, in Trust for Marcia Gesner
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this bodily Injury claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
