## ORDINANCE No. 188673

\*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Washington County for use of the County right-of-way for a Variable Message Sign on SW Barnes Rd (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- During inclement weather, the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) informs
  the public about road conditions and possible road closures due to snow, ice,
  slides or other conditions. An electronic variable message sign (VMS) is a timely
  and effective way of doing that in critical locations.
- 2. PBOT desires to purchase, install and maintain a VMS at West Burnside and SW Barnes Road, in a location within Washington County's right-of-way. The purchase of the VMS has been approved by Council in the FY 17-18 Fall BMP and sufficient funds are available in PBOT's FY 17-18 budget
- 3. Through the IGA, the County agrees to allow PBOT to use County right-of-way for the construction, operation and maintenance of the VMS at West Burnside at Barnes Road.
- 4. The County will share in the usage and operation of the VMS as part of a multiuse system. The County shall submit all messages to be activated on the VMS system to the City of Portland Traffic Operation Center (TOC). All use and operation of VMS system shall follow PBOT Policy.
- 5. The County shall be responsible for ongoing electricity costs associated with the operation of the VMS.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Portland and Washington County for the use of County right-of-way, in a form similar to the IGA attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to install the message board before possible emergencies due to inclement weather; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
