

ORDINANCE No. 188675

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder for construction of the Fremont Pump Station Upgrade Project No. E10543 for an estimated construction cost of \$1,440,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to upgrade the Fremont Pump Station to meet current BES standards, and to provide long-term reliability of conveying municipal wastewater in the collection system.
2. The level of confidence in the estimated cost for a construction contract for the Fremont Pump Station Upgrade project is high.
3. The estimated cost is \$1,440,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2018 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project number E10543.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.





