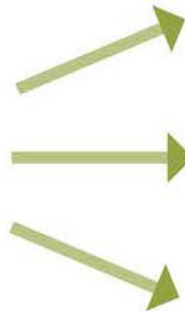

- Trifecta of support

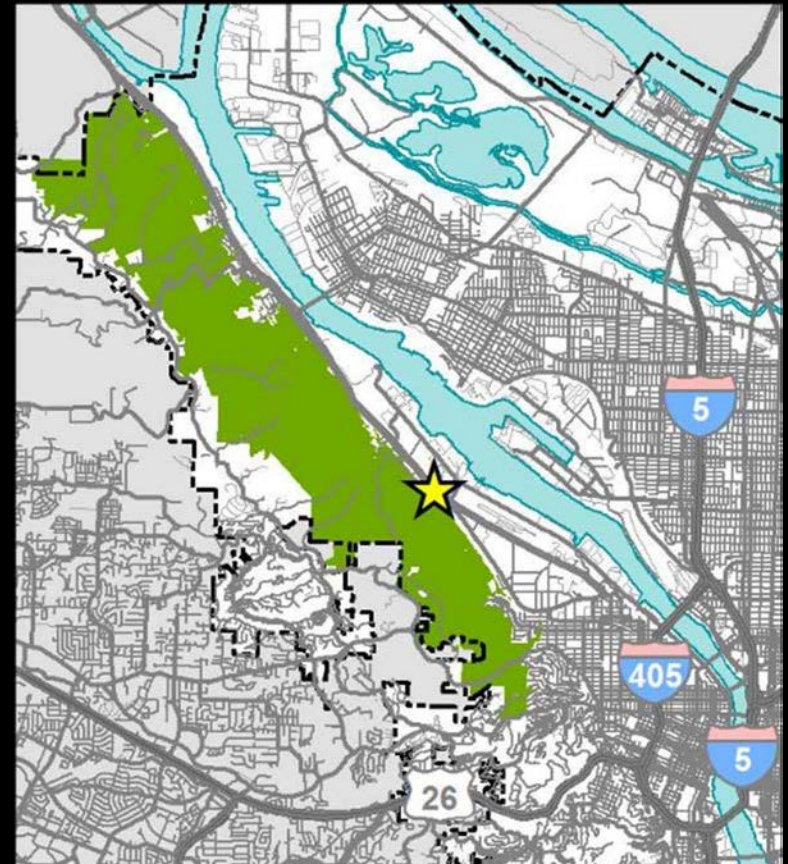


- **REBUILD FOREST PARK**
