

# ORDINANCE No. 188679

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder for construction of St John's Cathedral Park Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10330 for an estimated cost of \$7,740,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to rehabilitate approximately 15,000 feet of sewer main line in the north Portland neighborhoods of St. Johns and Cathedral Park.
2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating or replacing the deteriorated sewer pipe, including sewer manholes and service laterals.
3. The estimated cost is \$7,740,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 17-18, CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center, WBS Element E10330.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
