WHEREAS in November 2014, Portland City Council designated \$300,000 from 2014's fall supplemental budget for new master plans for eastside parks; and based on a public outreach process and Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) staff input, Commissioner Fritz chose three parks for improvement: Mill Park, Midland Park and the property at SE 150th Avenue and SE Division Street: and

WHEREAS PP&R developed master plans for the SE 150th AVE & SE Division ST Park Property; and

WHEREAS through its parks master planning process PP&R and its consultant team connected with community partners to gather valuable input with an intentional focus on engaging underrepresented, low income, refugee and immigrant communities in the area; and

WHEREAS the recommended design for the SE 150th AVE & SE Division ST Park Property reflect a collaborative effort involving neighbors and community groups to create welcoming spaces with activities for people of all ages; and

WHEREAS there is great enthusiasm and strong support among East Portland communities for improving the SE 150th AVE & SE Division ST Park Property; and

WHEREAS the design and plan for this park delivers on the City of Portland's pledge to enhance parks in East Portland.

NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of the City of Portland, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, affirms its acceptance of the 2017 SE 150th AVE & SE Division ST Park Property Master Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit A, as a guide for future use and development of the park.
