## ORDINANCE No. 188681

\* Authorize a grant agreement with VOZ Workers' Rights Education Project in an amount not to exceed \$31,516 to support Portland day laborers through trainings, wage claim services and marketing of worker center. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- VOZ Workers' Rights Education Project is a non-profit organization that supports Portland day laborers through trainings, wage claim services and marketing of worker center.
- VOZ opened the Portland Day Labor Hire Site on June 16, 2008. It has been an
  important community institution offering a safe and healthy place for workers while
  they wait for work. The Day Labor Hire Site also provides accountability to
  employers and protects workers from exploitation.
- 3. The FY2017-18 budget includes funding in the General Fund Special Appropriations for the above grant. The City now desires to make a grant to VOZ Workers' Rights Education project in an amount not to exceed \$31,516.
- 4. The City's Comprehensive Financial Management Policies, FIN 2.04-Budget, states that grants should be issued after a competitive application process, unless Council waives the policy in the grant ordinance. Since VOZ Workers' Rights Education Project is the only organization providing this service, a competitive application process was not implemented for this grant.

## NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$31.516
- b. The City Council waives the competitive application process required in FIN 2.04-Budget.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding will affect the VOZ Workers' Rights Education Project ability to continue providing services to the day laborers in the FY2017-18; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
