Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

To Authorize the City of Portland's Bureau of Parks and Recreation (PP&R) to amend the Pioneer Courthouse Square (PCS) contract for public involvement/engagement and public coordination services, by \$7,432.82, for a contract amount not to exceed \$70,432.82, to authorize \$75,000 in additional funding for critical security coverage, janitorial services and other as-needed parks maintenance service by the All User Restroom Attendant, and to authorize the payment of \$100,000 to Portland Courthouse Square, in the event that funding is granted to PP&R through the City of Portland's fall Budget Monitoring Process.. (Ordinance).

The new City All User Bathroom policy is being administered and facilitated by PCS.
