Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) protects public health, water quality and the environment. It provides sewer and stormwater collection and treatment services to accommodate Portland's current and future needs. BES protects the quality of surface and ground water and conducts activities that protect and restore our watersheds. The services provided by BES are paid by our ratepayers through user fees approved annually by Council.

This ordinance facilitates safe sewage collection, treatment and disposal for 38 SFR Maywood Park properties currently on cesspools that are contiguous to the City of Portland and Portland public sewer. This ordinance authorizes the Bureau to enter into an Interim Sewer Service Agreement with the City of Maywood Park to provide sewer service in accordance with Portland engineering specifications and sewer connection rates.

The ordinance is requested on an emergency basis so that one such property with a failed cesspool is authorized to connect to Portland public sewer.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

No budget changes in the current fiscal year are expected to result from this Ordinance. However, as the 38 tax lots connect, if and when their cesspools fail, the City will collect additional revenue.

Community impacts and community involvement:

The proposed ordinance will benefit Maywood Park residents by ensuring safe sewage collection, treatment and disposal.
