## ORDINANCE No. 188704

\*Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for Foster Road Streetscape Project: SE 50<sup>th</sup> – 92nd Ave to update the project scope and budget (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30005488)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- On June 11, 2013 City Council adopted the Foster Road Transportation and Streetscape Plan to improve multi-modal safety on Foster road and support the redevelopment goals of the Lents Town Center Urban Renewal District (Resolution No. 76729);
- 2. On June 29, 2016 City Council, authorized acceptance of an intergovernmental agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for the design and construction funding in the amount of \$3,313,402 of the Foster Streetscape Project (Ordinance No. 187853);
- 3. In 2016, \$3,000,000 of funding from the Fixing Our Streets gas tax became available for street reconstruction and paving of Foster Rd between 82<sup>nd</sup> and 92<sup>nd</sup> Ave which PBOT determined was best combined with the Foster Road Transportation and Streetscape for construction efficiency and coordination;
- The IGA amendment allows the federal aid project to update the project to include the additional street reconstruction and paving

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept and execute an Intergovernmental Agreement amendment in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by City Council.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
