ORDINANCE No. 188709 As Amended

*Authorize a grant agreement with APANO Communities United Fund not to exceed \$100,000 to support a part of the capital campaign to build a cultural center and permanent home for APANO (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. APANO (Asian Pacific American Network of Oregon) is a statewide, grassroots organization, uniting Asians and Pacific Islanders to achieve social justice. APANO was funded since 1996 and has become a critical cultural and civic home for Oregon's 250,000 Asian and Pacific Islanders. The organization works with over 7,000 supporters to address inequities their communities face.
- 2. APANO and ROSE Community Development Corporation were awarded the rights to redevelop the Jade APANO Multicultural Space (JAMS) as a four story, 48-unit affordable housing complex with a 5,000-square foot cultural center, public plaza and permanent home for APANO.
- The development is a Transit Oriented Development located on a major transit hub
 for the future Division Transit Project and will access to extensive transit options.
 The development will be a hub for local residents with social services including
 workforce navigation, small business support, and tenant counseling.
- 4. The development realizes a key component of the Jade District Vision, a multilingual community led planning effort that prioritizes the development of a neighborhood community space. The JAMS space at the pre-existing furniture site was used as an ad hoc community space and had 25,000 unique visitors annually
- The FY2017-18 budget includes funding in the General Fund Special Appropriations for the above grant. The City now desires to make a grant to APANO Communities United Fund in an amount not to exceed \$100,000
- 6. The City's Comprehensive Financial Management Policies, FIN 2.04-Budget, states that grants should be issued after a competitive application process, unless Council waives the policy in the grant ordinance. Since APANO Communities United Fund is the only organization providing this service, a competitive application process was not implemented for this grant.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$100,000.

- b. The City Council waives the competitive application process required in FIN 2.04-Budget.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding will affect the APANO Communities United Fund ability to build the cultural center and permanent home for APANO; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
